

# Homeowner Sentiment Survey April 2016





#### Methodology


The study was conducted among n = 2,506 respondents living in the U.S. The survey was fielded February 17 – 29 2016

Audience	Audience Definition	Sample Size	Margin of Error
Current Homeowners	Individuals who currently own a home as their primary residence	N= 2,001	+/- 2.2%
Prospective Homeowners	Individuals who do not currently own a home and are likely to buy a home as their primary residence in the next six months	N= 505	+/- 4.4%

#### **Executive Summary**


- Homeowner sentiment toward the real estate market is on the rise for the first time since we began this survey.
  - Prospective homeowners are also more likely to say that this year is a more ideal time to buy or sell.
  - After trending downward for the past two quarters, favorability toward the market has improved with 61% of current homeowners and 65% of prospective homeowners considering the real estate market as "favorable" or "very favorable."
  - Many current homeowners suggest that increasing interest rates are a sign that the real estate market is "heading in the right direction."
- With the spring buying season here, prospective homeowners reported seeing fewer challenges to buying their ideal home in the current real estate market.
  - 76% of prospective homeowners a survey group composed mostly of millennials and Gen-Xers said that this year is an ideal time to buy a home. That's an 11-point jump from the December Homeowner Sentiment Survey.
  - Overall, they are less likely to believe that housing inventory and new lending requirements are barriers to buying a home.
  - However, more prospects expressed concern that rising home prices will make it more difficult to buy a property.
- Real estate agents are in demand. Prospective homeowners seek more information from agents about financial aspects of the
  real estate process; they also want the confidence to move forward.



Lower interest rates are contributing to the positive outlook on the real estate market








#### Current and prospective homeowners believe that U.S. interest rates are holding steady

This wave, there is a slight increase among those who think rates will be on the rise




Current and prospective homeowners view the real estate market favorably heading into the spring buying season

If mortgage rates were to go up, how would you feel about the state of the real estate market?








## Prospective homeowners are more likely to say that this year is a more ideal time to buy or sell

Compared to last year, do you think this year is a...




### **Tradeoffs for the Ideal Home Today**


